Major Change: record syntax has been changed to conform to the Unification Code. The unification procedure expects syntax of the following form:

   [literal(left) ident(t1)]
   [literal(right) ident(t2)]]]
```

instead of

```
[record literal(tree)
  [literal(key)#ident(k)
   literal(left)#ident(t1)
   literal(right)#ident(t2)]]
```

### **v 1.0**

- In Question 1, [skip] is replaced by [nop]. This is done to avoid Oz keywords in the new language as far as possible.
- In Question 2, variables are now in lower case, identified as variables purely through “ident”. Also, skip is replaced with nop as in Question 1.
- From Question 3 onwards, variables are now in lower case.
- In Question 7, the syntax of subr has been corrected to be consistent with the previous syntax.
- Some stub code to demonstrate Dictionary usage has been added in Section 3.
