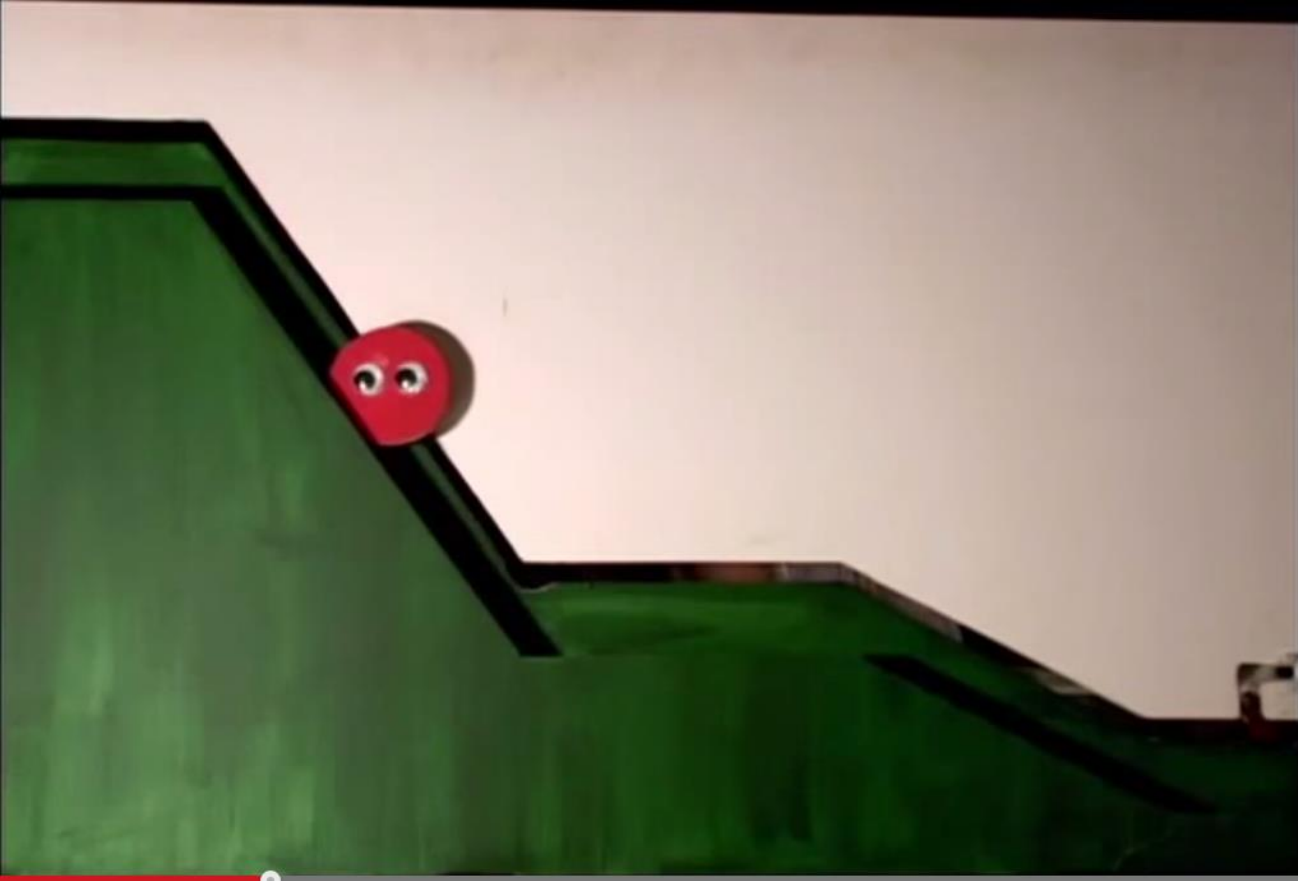
MOTIVATION
